Notice of Quarterly Public Hearing

Pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code Section 4301.06, the Ohio Liquor Control Commission is required to hold no fewer than 4 public hearings each year for the purposes of hearing general comments and complaints as to its policies, adopted pursuant to Chapters 4301 and 4303 of the Ohio Revised Code; considering other business and procedures of the Liquor Control Commission and receiving suggestions with respect thereto; and, for the dissemination of information to the public.

Additionally the Commission will receive comments and testimony concerning the eight (8) administrative rules of the Ohio Administrative Code enumerated below which are under five-year review for 2017:

- 4301:1-1-01 Title and validity
- 4301:1-1-03 Wine requirements
- 4301:1-1-22 Consent for importing alcoholic beverages for resale in Ohio
- 4301:1-1-24 Miscellaneous beer, wine, and mixed beverage requirements
- 4301:1-1-33 Consumer tasting activities and sampling at retail permit premises
- 4301:1-1-43 Furnishing signs, fixtures, equipment, advertising materials, and advertising specialties, return of merchandise: limitations thereon: prohibited practices and prohibition of cash deposit or prepayment
- 4301:1-1-62 Inspection of permit premises - hindering or assaulting forbidden
- 4301:1-1-71 Sponsorship of athletic events or tournaments, concerts, shows or entertainment

In compliance with this provision, the Ohio Liquor Control Commission will hold a public hearing on **Friday, December 9, 2016, at 10:30 am**. The public hearing will be held at the Riffe Center at 77 South High Street, 19th floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215. Anyone who wishes to speak to the issues of Commission policy, rules or wishes to make comments to the Commission relating to its business may do so at this time.
