Notice of Quarterly Public Hearing

Pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code Section 4301:06, the Ohio Liquor Control Commission is required to hold no fewer than 4 public hearings each year for the purposes of hearing general comments and complaints as to its policies, adopted pursuant to Chapters 4301 and 4303 of the Ohio Revised Code; considering other business and procedures of the Liquor Control Commission and receiving suggestions with respect thereto; and, for the dissemination of information to the public.

Additionally the Commission will receive comments and testimony concerning the eight (8) administrative rules enumerated below of the Ohio Administrative Code which are under five-year review for 2016, will propose a Resolution authorizing staff to *initial* file these eight (8) rules with CSI and JCARR, and will discuss the number of neon signs mentioned in OAC 4301:1-1-44(G) (more commonly referred to as “Rule 44”):

- 4301:1-1-64 Population estimates
- 4301:1-1-65 Procedure for hearings before the liquor control commission
- 4301:1-1-66 Advertising of proposed rules
- 4301:1-1-67 Sales reports of A-1 permit holders
- 4301:1-1-76 D-7 permit
- 4301:1-1-77 Notice of meetings
- 4301:1-1-78 Auctions by qualifying permit holders
- 4301:1-1-79 Restrictions on warrantless administrative inspections

In compliance with this provision, the Ohio Liquor Control Commission will hold a public hearing on **Wednesday, March 2, 2016, at 11:00 am**. Please note the midweek date for this hearing. The public hearing will be held at the Riffe Center at 77 South High Street, 19th floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215.
