RE: Withdraw of OAC 4301:1-1-11, Permits, procedure where quota is filled; and Revised BIA for OAC 4301:1-1-5, 4301:1-1-16, 4301:1-1-68, and 4301:1-1-73, Miscellaneous requirements concerning mixed beverages, closing authority, sales reports of B-1 permit holders, and differential practices.

On June 7, 2013, the Ohio Liquor Control Commission (“Commission”) submitted a BIA for a rule package that included the above-referenced rules, as well as OAC 4301:1-1-11 (Rule 11), entitled Permits, procedure where quota is filled.

Upon further consideration, the Commission has determined that additional review of Rule 11 by the Commission is warranted. The Commission believes that changes to Rule 11 would be appropriate at this time. Therefore, the Commission would like to withdraw Rule 11 from CSI review so that the Commission can complete a further review of this rule to make appropriate changes and to accept public comment on the proposed changes.

Thus, the Commission is submitting a revised BIA for the above-referenced rules. The revised BIA deletes the references to Rule 11.
