The Ohio Liquor Control Commission will hold a public hearing on ***Friday, February 6, 2015*** at 11:00 a.m. The public hearing will be held at the Riffe Center at 77 South High Street, 19th Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215. The purpose of this public hearing is to provide members of the public the opportunity to give comment and testimony and for the Commission to consider adopting for initial filing with CSI and JCARR the following rules:
