## Notice of Public Hearing

### 2017 and 2018 Five-Year Rules Review

The Liquor Control Commission is in the process of reviewing all of the following rules for 2017 and 2018. The Commission will hold a public hearing on *Friday, August 18, 2017* at 10:30 a.m. The public hearing will be held at 77 South High Street, 19<sup>th</sup> Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215. The purpose of this public hearing is to provide members of the public the opportunity to give comment and testimony.

First, concerning the Commission's Administrative Rules subject to five-year-review in **2017**, pursuant to section 119.03(C) of the Ohio Revised Code, the Commission will consider a resolution authorizing staff to *Initial File* the following "No Change" rules with the Common Sense Initiative ("CSI") and the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review ("JCARR"). The Commission previously held public hearings regarding these rules on December 9, 2016, March 10, 2017, and June 16, 2017. No changes were recommended for these rules.

- 4301:1-1-01 Title and validity
- 4301:1-1-03 Wine requirements
- 4301:1-1-22 Consent for importing alcoholic beverages for resale in Ohio
- 4301:1-1-24 Miscellaneous beer, wine, and mixed beverage requirements
- 4301:1-1-33 Consumer tasting activities and sampling at retail permit premises
- 4301:1-1-43 Furnishing signs, fixtures, equipment, advertising materials, and advertising specialties, return of merchandise limitations thereon: prohibited practices and prohibition of cash deposit or prepayment
- 4301:1-1-62 Inspection of permit premises – hindering or assaulting forbidden
- 4301:1-1-71 Sponsorship of athletic events or tournaments, concerts, shows, or entertainment

Second, the following Commission Administrative Rules are subject to five-year-review in **2018**.
